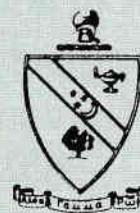

## Advisor Report



There have been relatively few glitches in what is rapidly becoming another terrific year for Alpha Gamma Rho Beta Gamma.

Recruiting last fall was difficult for some unknown reason. However, spring initiations will indeed carry us into the new millennium with the house at near full capacity, and will certainly keep the rice bag at bay.

Yes, membership numbers have gained over the year, quality has improved, and we currently enjoy having nearly 12% of the Male Agriculture Majors as members in our organization.

Chapter meeting attendance approaches 90%. At times we think we could get everyone here, but Ty Martin would have to make the trip from an internship at Disney World, and that would be a bit of a stretch.

Alumni relations continue to be as sound as they have ever been during my tenure. The chapter continues to meet deadlines for Crescent publication (4 years running), work on alumni addresses, and is planning to publish another directory this summer. Last one was dated Summer 1998.

The financial program which was developed several years ago is still in place. It has been at least 3 years since there has been any hint of a squabble over where the money goes, or how much is needed to be collected. We no longer are required to beg the alumni for funds to do leadership conferences or anything else. The result has been their gracious offer to provide an initiate rebate program this spring, remodel the 1<sup>st</sup> floor bathroom, put new carpet in the hall and on the stairs. They have plans for many other improvements.

The scholarship program continues to grow. The actives are indeed thankful to Dr. Loberger for the additional \$200 offered in his name for the first time last spring. Andy Schraufnagel was chosen as the first sophomore, who had been extremely active in AGR and campus leadership roles and maintained a 3.0 gpa. Andy's carrying a 3.8 gpa.

The UWP campus now has converted their greek leadership into an InterFraternity Council - complete with a new leader - and AGR has been extensively involved in that development and current leadership.

With regard to chapter management, we have revised and updated the constitution by-laws, started another scrapbook, attempted to get Ronny Rule to bring back

the initiation forms he took with him when he left his VNR Planning office, provided excellent officer transition complete with handbooks, held another annual retreat at AV's cabin, sent all officers to leadership conference, plan to send 4 delegates to Savannah, GA for the National Convention, and this year we even boast of having the OUTSTANDING ADVISOR of the Alpha Gamma Rho world in our presence.

Indeed, I have risen to the height of my incompetency - however, I do not plan to stay there forever. There is a strong likelihood that I will resign from the University this summer. I have told Scott Laufenberg that I would be happy to serve at least one more year in the capacity of the active advisor while the search is made for a replacement. I am more than willing to teach the new guy how to plow snow - avoid parties scheduled in honor of your belated birthdays - update the mailing list - and keep over active actives out of jail in other states!

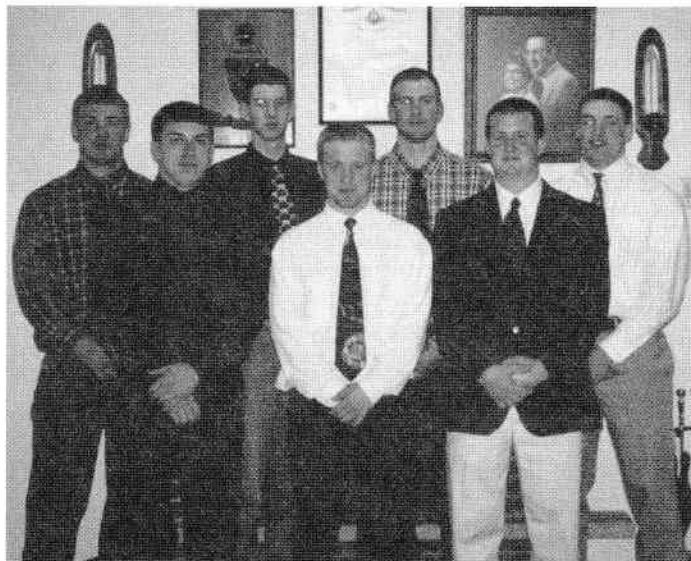
